

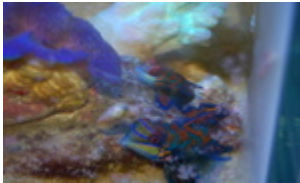


### SA "Onyx" Percs (*Amphiprion Percula*)
